HLTAID001 – Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

Course Overview

The Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (HLTAID001) course provides students with the contemporary skills and vast knowledge in administering CPR; a skill set essential for all to acquire.

Target Groups

Target groups for this qualification are those who are:

- Seeking to work in a trade that operates in a 'high-risk' area
- Seeking work in a childcare sector
- Seeking work in the healthcare sector
- Involved in gym areas, such as Personal Trainers
- Operating 'heavy vehicles' as an occupation (such as transport)
- In the hospitality industry
- Seeking to be a 'First Aid Officer' working in an office space with more than 25 employees
- All workplaces nationally must have one First Aid officer onsite

Delivery mode and location

Course Duration

Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Provide requires 1 day of Pre-Online Theory (24 hours before the commencement of the class) and 3 hours face-to-face training sessions with our qualified trainer.

Career Outcomes

Students who complete the Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation HLTAID001 unit are regarded as an asset to an array of organisations looking to hire staff. This provides students various opportunities as CPR accreditation is a mandatory requirement to enter range of industries in Australia.

Having a CPR ready employee creates a safe environment for the organisation and staff under which they are employed. If an injury were to arise, a CPR trained employee would be ready to act promptly to potentially save a co-worker or customers life.

Course Structure

Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation contains both theoretical and practical elements within its course guide. Students are required to demonstrate a satisfactory level for each given element to obtain a Statement of Attainment.

The student will be provided with information about possible alternative courses, additional tools and resources available, and options and choices for accessing a supportive network.

The information provided will vary depending on the individual needs of the student.

Requirements

Students must meet the following requirements:

- All students studying an Australian Course are required by the Australian Government to have (and present) a Unique Student Identifier (USI).
- All students must provide Primary and Secondary identification on the day of training, or alternatively, upload information as a PDF when completing their online enrolment.
- Basic numeracy and literacy skills must be shown through the Language, Literacy and Numeracy test (LLN) incorporated in the online enrolment process.
