Additional Support

All students will be provided with a range of learning support options and resources to help them achieve competency. This may include:

Entry Requirement

Australian Pacific Institute of Technology has the following entry requirements:

Students must:

- Participate in a course entry interview to determine their needs and assess suitability.
- Have sufficient language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) skills, for example, to be able to read the training materials and write assessment tasks. This will be tested through an LLN as part of the course entry process. Students will need to achieve ACSF level 2 for reading, writing, numeracy and oral communication to enter the course.
